This program will teach skills that will focus on Career Development, Living Independently, & Community Participation. Adler Academy will focus on learning and enhancing vocational and daily living and life skills to help prepare our clients for future employment by:

- Cooking basic/simple meals
- Proper table etiquette (setting silverware, napkins, etc) a skill in which is used in many restaurant jobs.
- Washing/drying dishes and how to properly use a dishwasher.
- Computer skills

- Office work
- Food service/money management
- Laundry service
- Janitorial/ housekeeping skills
- Childcare



PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- Small, Structured placements to enhance learning.
- Weekly classes that run 2.5 hours per day 2 times per week (Days & class times TBD)
- Small group cohorts with 6-8 participants
- Cohort 1- Tuesdays/ Thursdays 9:00-11:30 am
- Cohort 2- Mondays/ Wednesdays 3:00-5:30 pm
