The Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs (CYSHCN) program, operated by the Nassau County Department of Health, offers a comprehensive range of services at no cost. Our program aims to provide crucial information and facilitate referrals to health services and community resources tailored to children and youth with special health care needs.

To qualify for our services, individuals must be between the ages of 0 and 21, reside within Nassau County, and be suspected of having a developmental, physical, intellectual, emotional, or behavioral condition. This encompasses a wide spectrum of conditions, including but not limited to:

ADD or ADHD, allergies, anxiety, arthritis/joint problems, asthma, autism or autism spectrum disorder, behavioral/conduct problems, blood disorders, Cerebral Palsy, Cystic Fibrosis, depression, developmental delay, diabetes, Down syndrome, epilepsy/seizure disorder, genetic or inherited conditions, head injury, hearing problems, heart problems, intellectual disabilities, learning difficulties, migraines, other mental health conditions, muscular dystrophy, sickle cell anemia, speech or language disorders, substance use disorders, Tourette syndrome, and vision problems.
